Bivi adds, "The interest in natural refrigerants is growing steadily! Important manufacturers have presented significant case studies of installations with our products. Modine is very satisfied with what has been achieved so far! Of particular interest is the award that was presented by Accelerate Europe Magazine (recognizing excellence in advancing the adoption of natural refrigerants in Europe) to our customer Advansor for the installation they made for Stay Food in the Netherlands. Today it is the world's largest fully operational CO₂ installation - with 3.4 MW of cooling power - seven transcritical "V" gas coolers designed and manufactured by Modine."

"ATMO is a good container for dealing with the market and other equipment manufacturers," explains Chiechi. "Natural gas

used in the refrigeration sector is now a well-established reality, but the regulations are still on the table and must be set forth. In many countries, audits and debates are underway. In this scenario, the market is keen to evaluate all the useful proposals and in particular - for medium and large-scale installations - it seems that the introduction of CO2 systems is the preferred route. This makes us feel positive for the future!
