Planks™ and 50 cm x 50 cm squares.

- Increased thickness also offers better coverage of irregularities in the subfloor and lower sound transference from floor to floor.
- Constructed with a proprietary backing that is true loose lay and installs easily with TacTiles®.
- Built to ensure dimensional stability for great on-floor performance
- Designed with Ceramor™ ceramic bead coating to provide a durable finish that resists scratching and scuffing in challenging high-traffic spaces.
- Created with Sound Choice™ proprietary backing that meets acoustical sound requirements for absorbing sound and reducing vertical sound transfer, making Interface's LVT collection ideal for hospitality and multi-family environments.
- Constructed with materials and recycling in mind, including a commitment to deliver Environmental Product Declarations (EPDs) for all hard flooring products.
