

# Jacobs Selected for Copper Cathode Production Facility Pre-feasibility Study in Peru

Under the terms of the contract, Jacobs will provide capital expenditure (CAPEX) and operational expenditure (OPEX) estimates to Teck and Aurubis for determining project pre-feasibility. Teck and Aurubis' conceptual copper cathode production facility would incorporate their proprietary CESL copper-arsenic process technology – providing high copper and precious metal recoveries, controlled arsenic department, and reduced environmental impact compared to traditional pyrometallurgical smelter processing facilities in respect to air, dust and water.
