Eligible companies (headquartered in the U.S. with revenues of at least \$500 million) were evaluated September to January 2026 through: An independent survey of 25,000 U.S. residents, which resulted in 101,000 company evaluations, on three touchpoints of trust (customer, investor, employee); and social listening analysis (identification and assessment of what was said about a company on various media segments of the internet).
