FCCO- First Community Corp.

Expands Presence in Greenville, SC Market; Solid EPS Accretion w/Modest TBV Dilution

- FCCO announces financially attractive & strategic deal in Greenville, SC MSA
- Deal expected to be 5% accretive to 2018 EPS, 2.1% Dilutive to TBV w/ 3.5 yr. earn back.
- Deal increases asset base ~15% and should help accelerate growth in attractive MSA
- Adjust EPS, Boost Price Target to \$22 (+\$1), Reiterate Outperform

We reiterate our "Outperform" rating and increasing our Price Target to \$22 (+\$1) which reflects ~16.5x our 2018 EPS or ~185% of Tangible Book Value one year out.

We are trimming our Core 2017 EPS by \$0.02 to \$1.10 and increasing our Core 2018 EPS to \$1.30 (+\$0.07) to account for the acquisition of Cornerstone Bancorp. Our Core EPS forecast assumes the transaction closes on October 1, 2017 and excludes ~\$1.5 Million in projected pre-tax merger related expenses. Our forecast assumes no change to the current tax rate of approximately 27%; however, we estimate each 1% drop in the rate could add about two cents to 2018 EPS. Our EPS forecast corresponds to a ROAA and ROTCE of 0.90% and 10.5%, respectively, in 2018. We expect TCE to approximate 8.2% at close and increase to over 8.6% in 2018.

Transaction Details.

FCCO announced the acquisition of \$145 Million in Asset, Easley, South Carolina based Cornerstone Bancorp (CTOT) in a stock (70%) and cash (30%) deal valued at approximately \$26 Million. CTOT shareholders may opt to receive \$11.00 in cash or 0.54 shares of FCCO stock for every share of CTOT they hold. FCCO intends to fund the cash portion of the transaction via internal funds.

Terms of the transaction are (1) 39.7x LTM Earnings, (2) 14.1x 2018 EPS inclusive of projected cost saves, (3) 139% of Tangible Book Value (~160% of normalized TBV when adjusting excess capital), or (4) a 8.1% Core Deposit Premium (sans CDs). The transaction is slated to close in early 4Q17 with FCCO incurring approximately \$1.5 Million in one-time, pre-tax merger related expense. We estimate the systems conversion is a late 2017 or early 2018 event.

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We estimate the deal to be approximately 6% accretive to 2018 EPS. Tangible Book Value dilution is pegged at about 2.5% with an estimated earn back of 3.5 years. EPS accretion assumes no revenue enhancements, cost savings of 40%, and a gross credit mark of approximately 3.6% (\$2.6 Million). We project ~\$9.0 Million in Total Intangibles (~\$7.9 Million Goodwill & ~\$1.1 Million Core Deposit Intangible) will be added in conjunction with the transaction. We estimate Pro Forma Tangible Book Value at \$11.03 and TBV and TCE at close to approximate \$11.80 and 8.2-8.3%, respectively.

Overall, we see this transaction as a positive for FCCO as it makes strategic sense and is financially reasonable with mid-single digit EPS accretion in the first full year and an approximate 3.5 year earn back. Strategically, the deal expands FCCOs presence in the Greenville market (boosting its branch count to 4 from 1), bolsters its commercial lending talent and adds a solid core deposit franchise (71% Core Deposits sans CDs) with a low COF (39 bps vs 32 bps at FCCO). FCCO entered the Greenville MSA a year ago, hiring a local team of lenders and opening an LPO (transitioning to full service office in near term) in the market. The company has enjoyed good success in the market and the acquisition of CTOT will add increased scale and allow FCCO to more fully serve their customer base. Importantly, we expect loan and deposit growth to accelerate as the two teams come together. FCCOs' larger balance sheet will provide greater lending capacity to CTOT borrowers while CTOT's attractive deposit base provides FCCO good sales opportunity.

Additional Risks to Our Earnings Model Assumptions & Ratings:

Unexpected and/or rapid changes in interest rates may have significant negative impact on the company's balance sheet. Likewise, persistently low interest rates, and/or a flat yield curve may add downward pressure to revenues and the absolute level of NIM-Net Interest Margin.
