Savara Announces European and Australian Patent Offices Have Granted Patents for the Liquid Formulation of MOLBREEVI*, Providing Protection in Europe and Australia Until March 2041

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-- In December 2025, Savara and PARI Were Granted a Joint European Patent Covering the Investigational Drug-Device Combination of MOLBREEVI, Delivered Via PARI's Proprietary eFlow® Nebulizer System, Through March 2043

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LANGHORNE, Pa.--(BUSINESS WIRE)-- **Savara Inc.** (Nasdaq: SVRA) (the Company), a clinical stage biopharmaceutical company focused on rare respiratory diseases, today announced that the European Patent Office (EPO) has granted a patent covering the liquid formulation of MOLBREEVI, an orally inhaled recombinant human granulocyte-macrophage colony-stimulating factor (GM-CSF). European patent No.4121000 provides protection for MOLBREEVI through March 2041. Separately, the Australian Patent Office has also granted a patent, No. 62/990,810, covering the liquid formulation of MOLBREEVI, and securing protection in Australia through the same date.

"These patents further strengthen the Company's intellectual property portfolio for MOLBREEVI, providing an additional layer of defense in markets with no approved alternatives," said Kate McCabe, Chief Legal Officer, Savara. "Together, these patents reflect the strength of our liquid formulation IP across key ex-US markets. In parallel, we are advancing equivalent patent filings in the U.S., including a patent for the drug-device combination, with the aim of securing comprehensive protection across major commercial territories."

MOLBREEVI, delivered via the proprietary eFlow® Nebulizer System, has been granted Fast Track and Breakthrough Therapy Designations by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), Orphan Drug Designation by the FDA and by

the European Medicines Agency (EMA), and Innovation Passport (IP) and Promising Innovative Medicine (PIM) designations by the U.K.'s Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) for the treatment of autoimmune PAP.

About Autoimmune Pulmonary Alveolar Proteinosis (Autoimmune PAP)

Autoimmune PAP is a rare lung disease characterized by the abnormal build-up of surfactant in the alveoli of the lungs. Surfactant consists of proteins and lipids and is an important physiological substance that lines the alveoli to prevent them from collapsing. In a healthy lung, excess surfactant is cleared and digested by immune cells called alveolar macrophages. Alveolar macrophages need to be stimulated by granulocyte-macrophage colony-stimulating factor (GM-CSF) to function properly in clearing surfactant, but in autoimmune PAP, GM-CSF is neutralized by antibodies against GM-CSF, rendering macrophages unable to adequately clear surfactant. As a result, an excess of surfactant accumulates in the alveoli, causing impaired gas exchange, resulting in clinical symptoms of shortness of breath, often with cough and frequent fatigue. Patients may also experience episodes of fever, chest pain, or coughing up blood, especially if secondary lung infection develops. In the long term, the disease can lead to serious complications, including lung fibrosis and the need for a lung transplant.
